“Concepts and Principles of Myofascial Release

Myofascial (connective tissue) release encompasses the mechanical aspects of tissue, tissue neurophysiology, the understanding of circulation, and utilizes palpation skills to initiate systemic tissue changes through connective tissue mobilization. The techniques are indicated in cases of acute pain, muscle spasm, inflammation, and chronic joint and tissue restriction. Myofascial release techniques are applied with the awareness of patient response to treatment and awareness of tissues/area being worked thus can be gentle and controlled or moderately aggressive. These techniques can be implemented during all phases of the rehabilitation process.
