They help these kids develop enough confidence to make the right choices in life and encourage positive decisions which benefit both the individual as well as those around them. The staff members attempt to build resiliency and let these kids know they can reach for the stars, be who they want to be, and make their life worth living. They nurture their spirits to health and hold hope for them.

Every day the employees of Bellin Psychiatric Center hear the heart wrenching stories of the traumatic events that cause children to want to harm themselves or others. By intervening, they are able to help these children by caring for their physical and emotional needs, giving them hope that they didn't have before.
