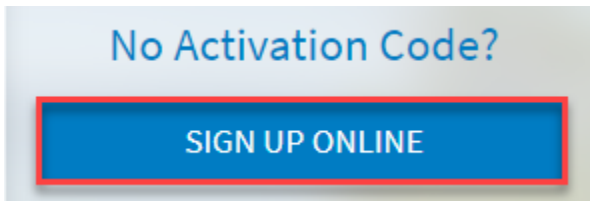
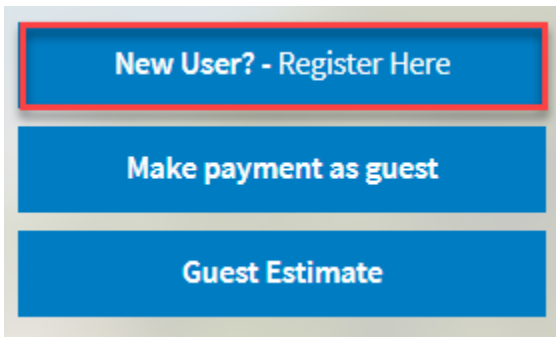

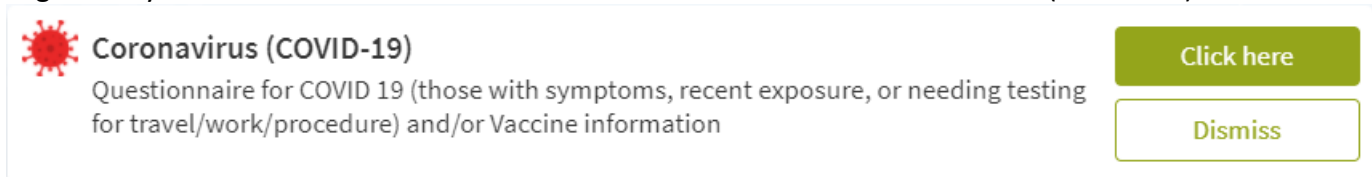
Try It Out

Go to MyBellin.org and login to your account.

If you don't have a MyBellinHealth account, click "New User?-Register Here". Then click "Sign Up Online". Follow the prompts to get an account.



1. Login to MyBellinHealth and click on the "click here" button for the Coronavirus (COVID-19) banner.



2. Click on the “Coronavirus/COVID-19 Vaccine” box.

At this time, the COVID-19 vaccine is only available from us for the following individuals:

Please review the criteria below carefully. If you live in a nursing home/assisted living facility, please check with your facility.

For Wisconsin:

1. An individual who provides direct patient service or essential worker. Examples include healthcare workers, paramedics, police, fire fighters, dental and orthodontists, public health workers providing vaccines and public health workers providing COVID-19 testing.
2. An individual who engages in healthcare services. Examples include in a patient care setting: environmental services, food and nutrition, buildings and grounds, pharmacists, pharmacy assistants, lab personnel, security personnel, spiritual care providers, social workers, case management and transportation services.
3. An individual who is 65 years and older starting January 25th, 2021.

For Michigan:

Phase 1A: Paid and unpaid persons serving in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials and are unable to work from home as well as residents in long-term care facilities.

Phase 1B: Persons 65 years of age or older and frontline essential workers in critical infrastructure which includes pre-kindergarten through high school teachers, support staff and child care workers. First responders not covered in Phase 1A: firefighters, police, conservation officers, inspectors. Correction workers: staff in prisons, jails, juvenile justice facilities. Workers in homeless shelters, congregate child care institutions, and adult and child protective services.

Group C: Other frontline essential workers.

5. Click “Acknowledge” if you agree with the statement.

By clicking acknowledge, you know that your responses will be used to identify your eligibility to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at this time. You also acknowledge that you are responsible for any consequences of submitting false answers and that you may be asked to validate your eligibility at any time. By clicking "acknowledge" below, you further attest that your responses above are truthful and accurate and will be documented in your permanent medical record.

6. Answer the following questions and then click “continue”

Have you ever had a severe allergic reaction to any vaccine, injectable medication, or any of their components? A severe allergic reaction is defined as swelling of the lips, tongue or throat, shortness of breath, or trouble breathing.

Have you received any infusion antibody therapy or convalescent plasma as treatments for COVID-19?

Have you received any other vaccine within the past 14 days?

Are you currently pregnant and/or breast feeding?
